<b>Start-up sense check</b>	Before you go too far down the track with your business idea, it's important that you get advice on whether it is legally feasible and the possible legal issues you may have to deal with.	\$1000
<b>Structuring advice</b>	There are often questions about how to best structure your business and its ownership. We can give you some high level advice on the options available. You should also get tax advice from your accountant.	\$1000

<b>Shareholders agreement</b>	An agreement between the shareholders of your company covering matters such as governance, decisions requiring shareholder approval, issue and sale of company shares, and non-compete obligations.	\$1000
<b>Subscription agreement</b>	An agreement between the company and an investor who is buying shares of the company.	\$500
<b>Deed of access and indemnity</b>	An agreement between a director and the company which gives the director access to company records and which gives the director an indemnity from the company for certain conduct.	\$500
<b>Discretionary trust deed</b>	A deed to create a trust which can be used to hold shares in your company.	\$300 <sup>2</sup>
<b>Employee share plan or option plan</b>	An employee share plan or option plan based on the Australian Taxation Office model documents.	\$500
<b>Employment agreement</b>	A standard employment agreement you can use for employees of your business.	\$500
